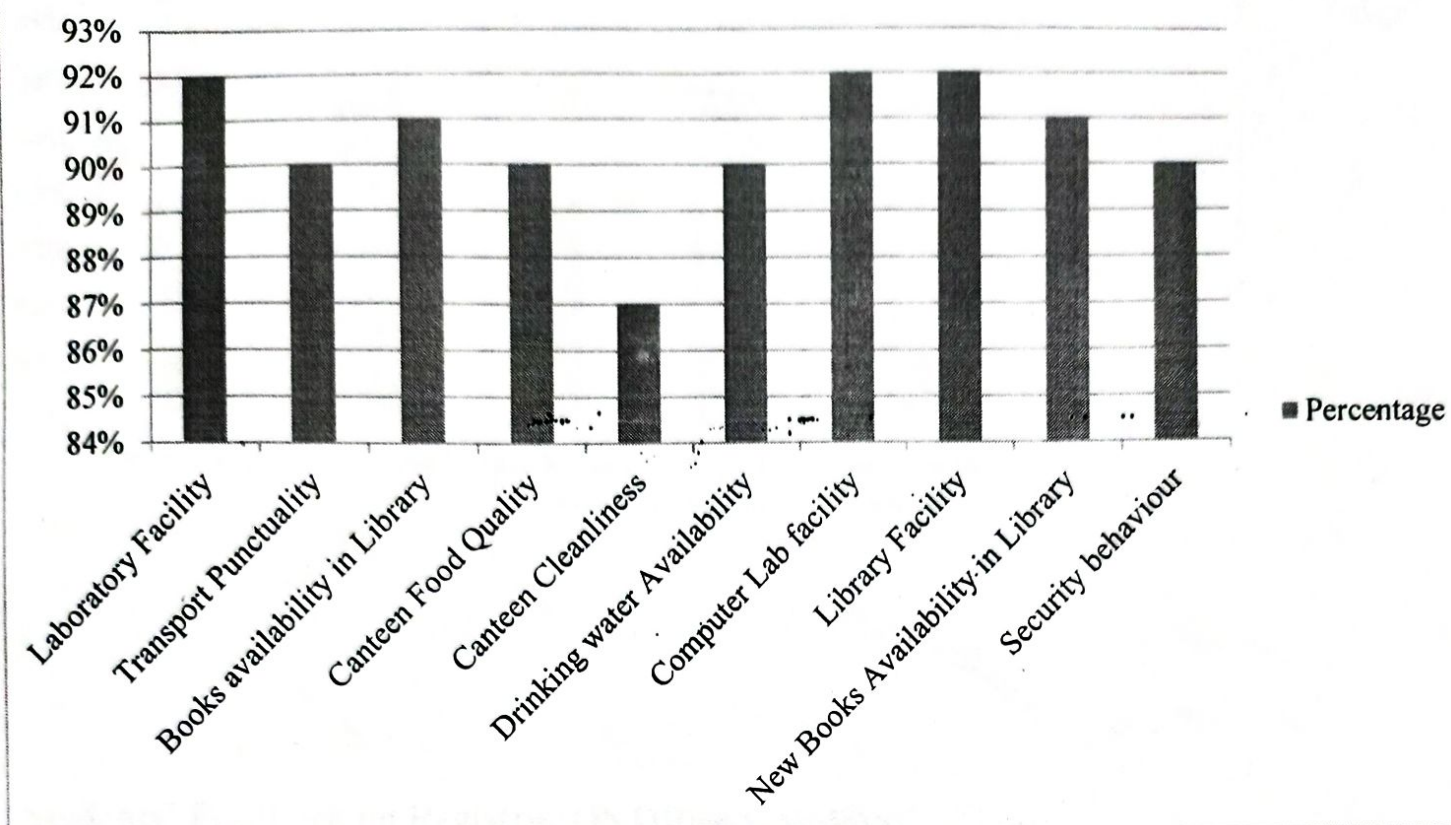

Internal Quality Assurance Cell

The college has established a system to gather structured feedback online/Offline from students and other stakeholders.

The IQAC of the college designed and approved the feedback form, which is available on the college's website. Responses are collected both online and offline from employers, educators, alumni, and parents. All feedback is presented to the Principal and management team for review and potential action. The comments and suggestions are considered when assessing the overall quality of education and student conduct.

Action Taken: The collected feedback is reviewed by the administrative staff, which compiles a report and submits it to the Principal, who then forwards it to the Management. The HOD takes necessary actions, such as improving facilities, scheduling more frequent lectures and practical sessions, and notifying the relevant teachers. This analysis is made available to all staff, both teaching and non-teaching, who are expected to take responsibility for its implementation.

Student Feedback Action Taken Report

After taking feedback from students, certain points were discussed and solutions were provided for them.

Sr. No	Particular	Action Taken
1	Suggestion for Smart Board	College launch the smart board and HOD suggest all faculty to use the Smart Board to develop interactive lessons that go beyond traditional teaching methods.

2	Advance learner Suggesting more hands-on, real-world projects as part of the curriculum, which can increase engagement and deepen understanding.	The Department of Science & Commerce has introduced several add-on and value-added courses to improve students' employability. These include iOS, Soft Skill Development, Python Programming and SQL.
3	Certain subjects (e.g: Maths, Electronic, Stast, Advanced C ,Data structure, Advanced Accounting ,BRF,) have been found to be challenging for slow learners to grasp.	The Head of Department has instructed teachers to conduct remedial sessions on topics identified as difficult for UG Student.
4	Suggestion for Sports Activity	In addition to academics, the physical director has shared the sports schedule. Also regularly Organized sports events
5	Provision of full day light facilities at the basement classrooms	We have implanted solar light in the basement classrooms.
6	Recommendation for Maintaining Health and Cleanliness in the Canteen	The canteen staff followed strict hygiene protocols to ensure food safety and prevent contamination Suggested precaution measures to canteen manpower

EMPLOYER Feedback Action Taken Report


After taking feedback from Employer, certain points were discussed and solutions were provided for them.
