- Patent is an Intellectual property right relating to inventions. It is an exclusive and
 monopoly right granted to the inventor by the government to use the patented invention for
 a limited period of time (20 years), thus preventing others from making, using importing or
 selling in exchange of full disclosure of his invention.
- In 1856, George Alfred De Penning a civil engineer, of Calcutta Petitioned the Government of India for grant exclusive privileges for his invention "An Efficient Punkah Pulling Machine."
- A Trade Mark is any word, name, symbol or device (or any combination thereof). It
 identifies and distinguishes the sources of the goods or services of one trader from those of
 others. It provides exclusive monopoly over a class of goods or services.
- A Copyright is a type of intellectual property that gives its owner the exclusive right to copy and distribute a creative work, usually for a limited time. The creative work may be in literary, artistic, educational, or musical form.
- Works covered under copyright are literary, Dramatic, Musical of Artistic Works, Anonymous & Pseudonymous Works, works of public undertakings & Government Works, Works of International Organizations, Sound recording and Cinematograph Films.
