- To know how to deal with this pandemic stress.


Outcome of the Webinar:

Prof. Swati Patil ended the programme vote of thanks.



Highlights of the Session:



Highlights of the event:


CA Ajit Pusegaonkar, gave brief introduction about his journey till date. He told about how he tackled all obstacles which led to his successful career in Banking Industry.
