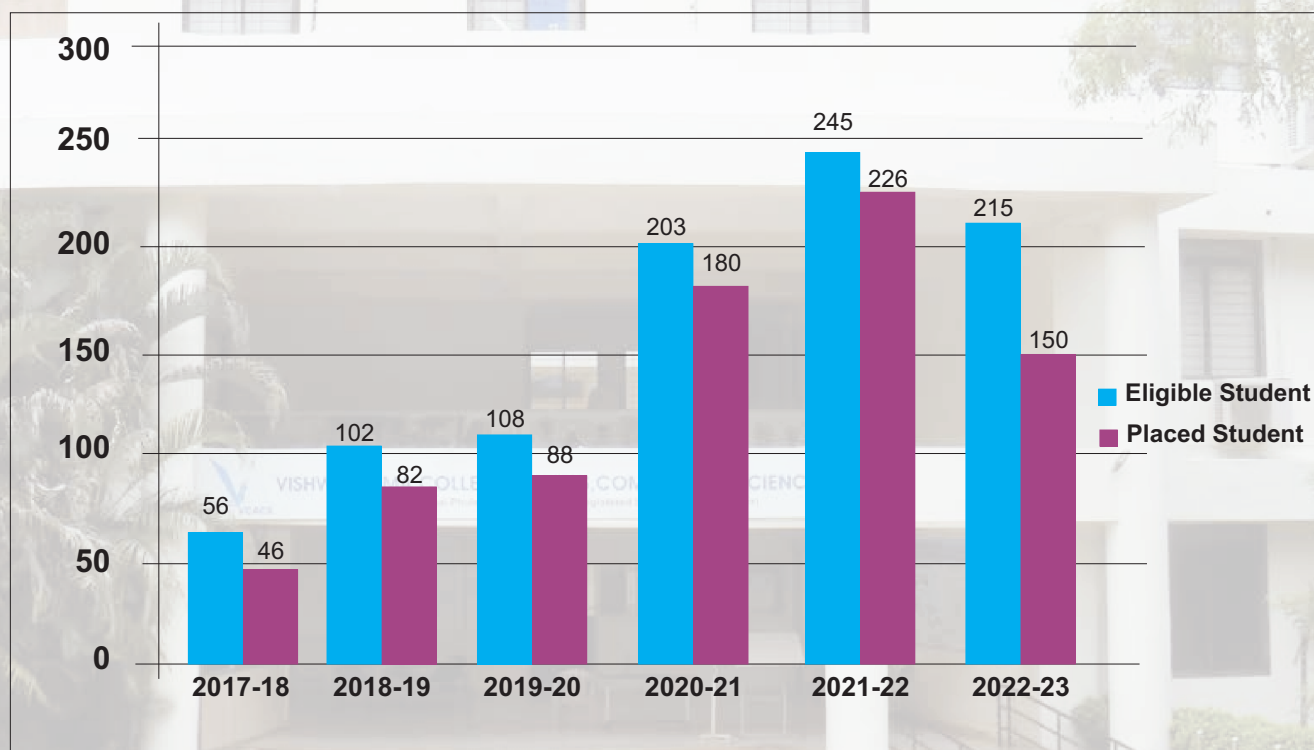

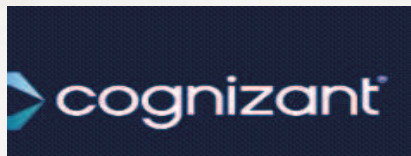

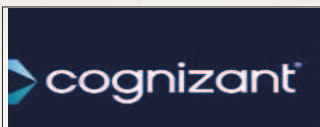

A placement cell, also known as the Career Development Center or Training and Placement Cell, is a department in educational institutions such as colleges and universities that aims to facilitate the recruitment of students for job opportunities after they graduate and establish a successful career for themselves.
