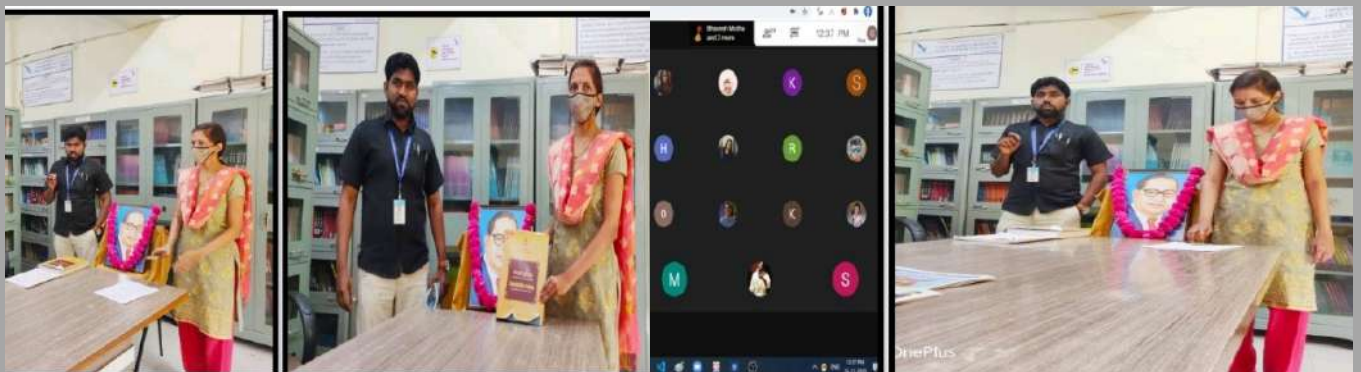
## ***Constitution day***

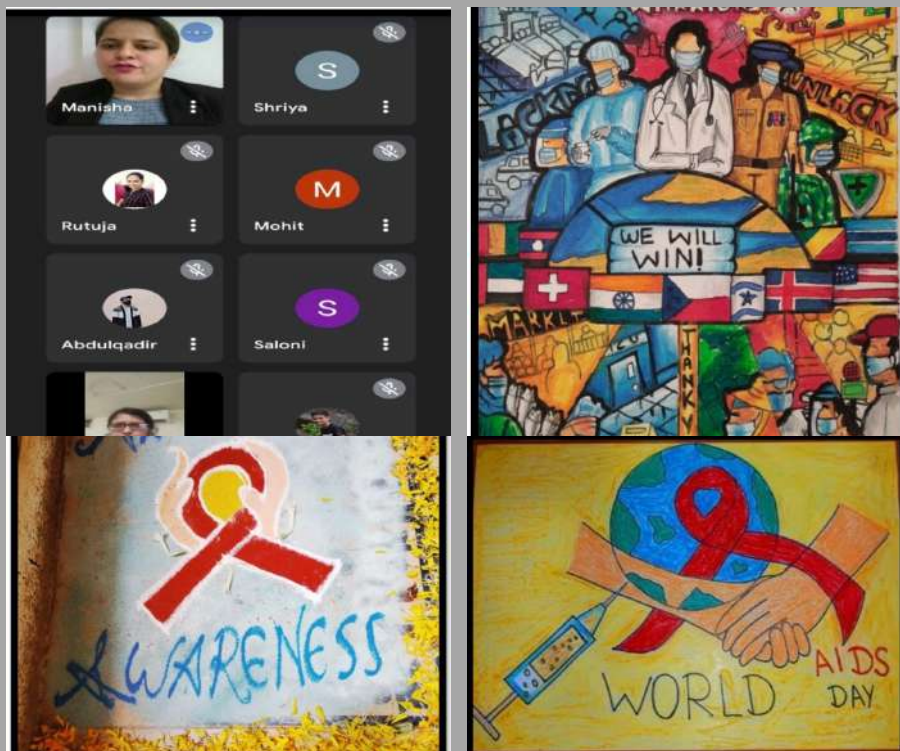
## ***AIDS Awareness***
